



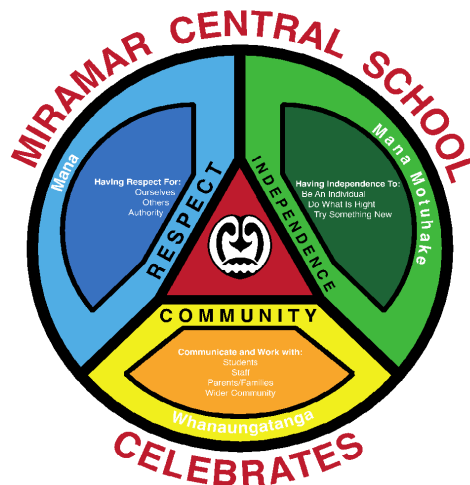
**KO JACKIE
